Lake-Lehman Marching Band COVID Rehearsal Guidelines July 23, 2020

The marching band will follow all guidelines and protocol set forth by the Lake-Lehman School District Athletics Reopening Plan (<u>https://www.llsd.org/Athletics</u>). <u>All students must return the signed COVID wavier and marching band paperwork before they are able to participate in rehearsals.</u>

Rehearsal Arrival/Departure

- Students must wear masks
- Parent/guardian must remain on-site until student is checked in to rehearsal. Upon arrival, students will have their temperature checked and verbal health well-being verification. Any student with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be sent home.

Rehearsal Procedures

- Each student will bring a water bottle, labeled with their name to rehearsal.
- Each student will wear a mask as required by the Athletics Reopening Plan.
- Each student will transport individual instruments, mallets/sticks, and equipment (colorguard flags/rifles) to and from rehearsal. Small instruments/equipment will not be stored at school.
- Large instruments (percussion battery and front ensemble) will be stored at school and sanitized before and after each rehearsal.
- Students will not share any personalized equipment or instruments.
- Students will use individual music, flip folders, and music stands.
- Instrumentalists will use instrument covers. Procedures will be established to properly empty brass instruments.
- Activities including chewing gum, spitting, licking fingers, eating sunflower seeds, fist bumps, high fives, shaking hands, and unnecessary physical contact with other individuals are prohibited per CDC guidelines.
- Social distancing guidelines will be followed at all rehearsals.
- Equipment and rehearsal space will be sanitized.
- All rehearsals are closed rehearsals (only students and staff in attendance).

Students will need to follow quarantine procedures established by the governor if they travel, or plan to travel, to an area where there are high amounts of COVID-19 cases and stay at home for 14 days upon return to Pennsylvania. Identified states include Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, and Wyoming.
